### CONCESSIONAL LICENSING (Code 404)

#### **REPORT**

As requested at the October 2017 CMC Committee Meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> October I sent an email to Rebecca Prodoti and Courtney Hoy from DVS Licensing Policy, Department of Transport requesting the following:

1. Clarification as to whether or not the conditions of use for concessionally licensed vehicles are relaxed for the National Motoring Heritage Day and for Anzac Day, effectively allowing normal use on those days.
2. Acknowledgment that although the CMC is not an authorised historic motor vehicle club in its own right, it can host and organise events involving concessionally licensed vehicles.

I received a response from Courtney the next day requesting more information. This included questioning where the vehicles would be going on those two days or was “just out on the roads going anywhere and everywhere”. I confirmed that for the NMHD, the latter was our understanding. I got back to Courtney and explained further, but on 23<sup>rd</sup> October she said that they would need more time to provide answers as they would need to carry out more research. I was

informed that they would be back to me “soon”, but I have heard nothing since.
