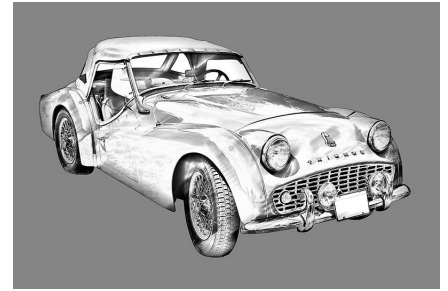

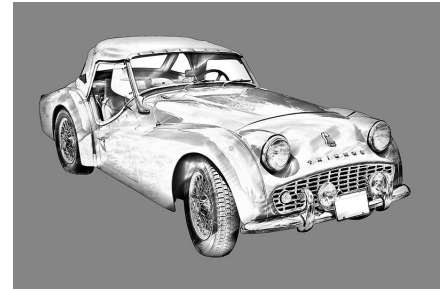

More than 350 high school students from 12 – 15 years old will enjoy their introduction to the world of classic motoring. This is an initiative that all classic car enthusiasts would no doubt support.

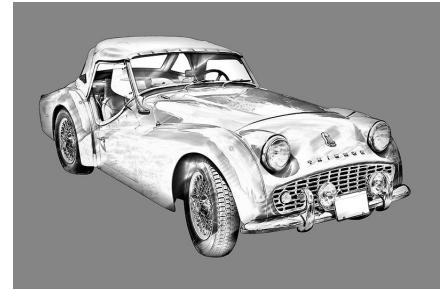
