Registrar’s Report: Andrew Wells. Concessional Registrar

The surge of conversion to concession after licences were increased to \$90,has subsided. It now seems to be only new members or existing members who have bought another car. I know if you have two in the shed they will breed.

The CMC1 form has been altered and now requires the signature of the person actually certifying the originality of the vehicle. I rely on those members who were scrutineers when we had yearly inspections to check cars in their area. We have 270 vehicles on concessional licence saving our members thousands of dollars in licence fees as well as cheaper insurance. Please keep to the the rules to protect our right to these concessions.

A reminder, if you buy a vehicle on full licence and intend to have it on concession, wait to put in the transfer form until you have the CMC1. That way you will avoid stamp duty on the transfer. If you are wanting to put a licenced vehicle onto concession please email me a scanned copy of the licence paper. If you use a phone camera to make a copy please make sure it is legible. I also need to know if the HISTORIC plates will be fitted above or below the number plate or, if that is impractical, you need stickers. Enjoy your car but don’t use it to go to work each day.

There is plenty of old at Coorinja!

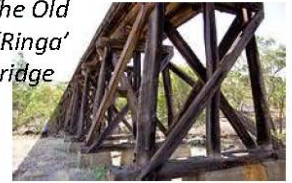
This old burner cart used to be pulled by horses between the rows
